Press "Yes" (or "keep" on recent versions) to keep all CSA settings the same, or press "No" (or "Reset" on newer versions) to reset all CSA settings to the default configuration. It will have no effect on saved signal data.

Once the update process is finished, press **Close**. Finally restart the CoCo-80.
